
1. Socialist Alliance is a **political organisation** to help build a socialist future through the self-emancipation of the working class- not a sect, a league of the pure, or a friendship group



Socialism for the 21st Century

- 1.To convert mass uprisings into revolutions, a political instrument capable of overcoming the dispersion and fragmentation of the exploited and the oppressed is required.
- 2. Convince not impose.
- 3. Respect for grassroots movements, and contribute to their autonomous development.
- 4. Democratic discussion and decision-making, unity in action, respect minorities (which can be right).
- 5. Promote unity of the left and all social forces fighting the capitalist system.


