There must be political change if we are to have climate action, social justice and job-secure futures.

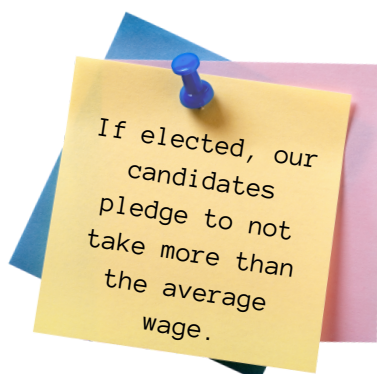

Socialist Alliance says...

FOR MAKING BILLIONAIRES PAY UP we need to:

- Make big companies pay tax and return rorted JobKeeper payments; introduce a wealth tax for the super rich;
- End subsidies to mining, banking and energy corporations.

FOR URGENT ACTION ON THE CLIMATE CRISIS we need:

- Zero carbon emissions and 100% renewable energy by 2030;
- Guaranteed alternative jobs with no loss in pay for workers in fossil fuel industries.

FOR COVID-19 and PUBLIC HEALTH we need:

- Massive investment in public health and a 25% wage increase for Aged Care workers;
- Free, accessible Rapid Antigen Tests (RATs) for all and paid pandemic leave on top of sick leave;
- Zero bullying of COVID-positive workers to return to work.

FOR LIVING INCOMES FOR ALL we need to:

- Increase minimum wages to \$25/hour and recognise the right to secure work for all;
- Scrap anti-union laws preventing workers from organising;
- Lift all welfare payments above the poverty line.

FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE RIGHTS we need to:

- Negotiate a treaty with First Nations peoples;
- End the detention of refugees and grant permanent residency;
- Stop cutting NDIS funding;
- Undertake a large-scale expansion of quality public housing;
- Implement real action to stop violence against women and children.
